23 RIOJA BLANCO (O)

Bodegas Muga, Rioja Alta, Spain

Classic white Rioja, full bodied and dry, with a crisp fruitiness and a good dollop of creamy vanilla oak. The grapes, 90% Viura and 10% Malvasia, are slow fermented in new French oak after which the wine spends 3 months on fine lees.

Moncaro, Ancona, Marche, Italy

Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi, to the west of Ancona, about 30km from the Adriatic, is too often rather bland a wine but, with grapes from a single vineyard, made by someone like the talented oenologist, Giuliano d'Ignazi, who heads up the wine making for the Moncaro team, it becomes a different beast.

Stylistically this superb Saint-Veran represents a sort of halfway house between Macon Blanc and Pouilly Fuisse: it has the floral quality of a Macon Blanc but with greater body and extract. Classic Maconnais Chardonnay at its best. Guy and Annie Saumaize run this 10-hectare estate with passion and total dedication.

Guy's other job is growing young vines for other growers (pepinieriste) and, as you can imagine, he takes viticulture very seriously. Careful selection of grafts to match the correct soil-type is somewhat of a speciality and this, coupled with some meticulous wine-making, ensures wines that have vivid fruit flavours and excellent concentration.

28 RESERVA CHARDONNAY (O)

Casas del Bosque, Casablanca, Chile A new find - an intense, fruit driven Chardonnay from cool climate vineyards in Chile

On the nose aromas of walnut, ripe pear and quince dominate. In the mouth a citrus backbone is fleshed-out by ample mineral and peach notes finishing with a very subtle smokey/woody note. A spell in oak (some new) adds to the complexity of this excellent, full bodied Chardonnay.

29 MEURSAULT 'VIEILLES VIGNES' (O)

Domaine Paul Garaudet, Burgundy, France

This is a truly remarkable Meursault. Full of rich layers of buttery fruit, underlying mineral roundness and texture with an amazingly long persistent finish. Wonderful. Paul Garaudet had to learn things the hard way as he took over this important 15-hectare domaine following the sudden death of his father when he was only eighteen.

Now in his late-forties, he has carved out a reputation for himself as one of the finest growers and wine-makers in Monthélie, a sleepy village in a valley just to the west of Meursault.

In the winery, Henry relies on gravity to move his wine around, thereby reducing its contact with air so that sulphur dioxide can be avoided during the fermentation. All this means that these wines are as natural and eco-friendly as it is possible to buy! Very aromatic with exotic fruit. Hints of Earl Grey and roses on the nose lead to a voluptuous mouth feel with good balance, and a touch of honey on the palate. Delicious, medium dry, very rich, ripe and up front.

38 DR LOOSEN ESTATE RIESLING

Ernst Loosen, Bernkastel, Mosel, Germany

Riesling from Germany is like no other wine, with a wonderful balance of acidity and fruit sweetness, along with a variety of appealing aromas - honey, lime and a hint of petrol. The Dr L is a lightish style, very fresh and perfectly balanced, and of Kabinett quality, even though he chooses to declassify to Qualitätswein. Although there is some residual sweetness, the perfect balancing acidity make it a superb match for a huge variety of dishes, from spicy Asian flavours to Charcuterie and offal. Enrique Mendoza, Alicante, Spain

La Tremenda comes from a single vineyard planted 16 years ago at 600 meters altitude with lime and sand soils with plenty of stones. It was fermented in stainless steel and aged in 500-liter oak barrels for six months. The nose is open and expressive, with mostly red fruit that provides freshness, pomegranate, raspberries and red cherries along with red licorice and Mediterranean herbs. Juicy and accessible, it is a real pleasure wine and true to its birthplace and variety. Enrique Mendoza is one of the classical names in Alicante.
